Dear Parent/Carer,

RE: Pembroke at the Beach: Wednesday 17th July 2024

At Priory Pembroke Academy we have the motto: "Achieving Together". As a way of showing that this motto permeates through all Academy life, we have arranged an accessible end of year trip that all students and staff will be involved in.

On Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> July, all members of Priory Pembroke Academy will be going to Mablethorpe to enjoy a day at the beach. At £12.50, the cost for the trip has been subsidised in order to allow everyone to access the day. Students will be allowed to bring a sensible amount of money to purchase food and drink and to use in any other responsible way. Students in receipt of free school meals will have a packed lunch provided if requested. Students will not be expected to wear the Academy uniform although they must ensure they are dressed in a respectful and appropriate manner. The Headteacher reserves the right to refuse a child's participation on the trip if they deem their clothing to be inappropriate. Their decision is final.

There will be planned activities during the day for students to engage in including sand sculpting, beach rounders, frisbee games and others. Students will also be granted unsupervised time in specific areas of Mablethorpe with restrictions such as ensuring they are in groups of no less than three. Students will not be allowed to enter the sea for safety reasons.

In the light of Government directives, to cover costs, parents/carers are asked to make a voluntary contribution of £12.50 per student, this being the average cost per student in order to make the trip economically viable. This price includes the travel cost of the return journey to Mablethorpe. There is no obligation to contribute, but equally the visit can only go ahead if there is an adequate level of support. Obviously, should contributions not be sufficient to make the visit economically viable, the Academy reserves the right to cancel the visit. Although all students are invited to take part, please note that the Headteacher reserves the right to make the final decision as to whether any student should or should not be involved.

If your child would like to attend this trip, please ensure that you have logged in to parent pay to provide consent and payment no later than Friday 28<sup>th</sup> June. No other forms of payment or consent can be accepted and they cannot be accepted after this date. In order to ensure the trip is financially viable, all payments and consent must be made by Friday 28<sup>th</sup> June. No payment or consent will be accepted after this date. Any children not attending the trip must attend school as usual on the day.
