Equipment for examinations

As your child moves through year 10 and towards their GCSE year 11, they will start to undergo a series of mock internal examinations. These examinations are to assess performance, checking they are on track to achieve their target grade, but also to ensure all students are aware of and fully prepared for examination regulations and processes.

To help students feel more prepared, it is vital that they have all the equipment required for each examination series. Equipment should be brought into the examination room in a clear plastic pencil case, do not use a solid tin for maths equipment. The equipment required is to include,

Black biros, ideally more than one, calculator, ruler, eraser, pencil, protractor, compass & highlighter.

Your child's Head of Year will discuss further regulations and requirements with them as they approach the first set of internal examinations in year 10.
