RE: Lincolnshire “Stay Safe Day” Programme for Year 10

Dear Parent/Carer,

At Pembroke we have a comprehensive personal development programme which includes a dedicated lesson every week through PSHMRE lessons and delivery of SMSC through form time. We also work with outside agencies to support students’ personal development, including the Lincolnshire County Council ‘Stay Safe Partnership’ who run ‘Stay Safe Days’ in school. The 'Stay Safe Days' programme aims to improve personal safety by making pupils aware of the consequences of their actions on themselves, their families, and the community.

On Wednesday 1st May your child will follow a program of five subject areas are given by different agencies:

1. “County Lines” Awareness by Lincolnshire Police
2. Road Safety by Lincolnshire Road Safety Partnership
3. Online Safety by Lincolnshire Safeguarding Children Partnership
4. Alcohol and Drug Awareness by We Are With You
5. Cyberstalking by Lincolnshire County Council

The programme has had some excellent feedback from students across Lincolnshire because it does not tell them what to do, but gives them the facts and safety tips about the subject and raises awareness about what could happen if they take certain steps.

Some of the information in the sessions is hard hitting, and there are photos and videos which we think are suitable for Year 10 pupils, however, we are aware that some students may be sensitive to them due to personal experience or circumstances.
